We had 1 player land on the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole, 1 player landed on the 5<sup>th</sup> hole & 2 players land on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. Remember, the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole is for handicaps 10 & over, the 5<sup>th</sup> hole is for handicaps 9 & under, and the 18<sup>th</sup> hole is open for everyone.

Please remember to take a sand bucket with you on your round and fill any divots that you create in your play. Also, if you know how to, please also repair pitch marks on the green, if you are unsure of how to make these repairs, there are several members who can assist.
