Miss/MS Key West Pride Pageant Rules & Regulations

Rules and Regulations

- The pageants are to be held at the 801 Bourbon Bar Upstairs Cabaret at 6pm to 9pm. The contestants should arrive no later than 6pm unless otherwise instructed. Contestants should arrive in make-up and dressed. A changing area will be provided upstairs at the 801 Cabaret.
- There will be 3 outfits required for the pageant that must be supplied by the contestant:
 1. Presentation (Pride Rainbow Wear)
 2. Talent
 3. Question and Answer (Evening Gown) – you can wear this for crowning or change into something different.
- Category 1: Presentation
This is a runway presentation of you. At this time, what you fill in on your application will be read to the audience and judges. This is your time to show yourself in what you feel best represents you in style & flair.
- Category 2: Talent
This category allows you to show off what you do best. The talent portion of your performance will not exceed 6 minutes total time allowed. Two of the 6 minutes may be used for set up, (props, backup dancers, etc.). Point deduction will occur for exceeding the six minute time limit. You must provide TWO (2) CD'S or a USB storage card upon arrival at the pageant so DJ can get ready for contest and avoid technical difficulties. Please keep music, lyrics, and overall performance in good taste and entertaining to a broad audience.
- Category 3: Question & Answer (Evening Gown)
You will be asked a question written by one of the judges, selected at random from the hostess. Your evening gown should represent you in your best light. Keep in mind that the questions will revolve around Pride and the Key West Community.
- No Crowns or tiaras may be worn or used during presentation, talent or evening gown portion of the competition.
- All contestants are allowed one dresser or make-up artist during the Pageant.
- The use of illegal substances during the pageant will be grounds for disqualification.
- The organizer, owner of the pageant, and or establishment where the pageant is to be held cannot be liable for any damages or loss of contestants' property or possessions.
- Any contestant who tampers with the property of another contestant will be automatically disqualified
- All decisions made by the judges are final; however, contestants have the right to review their scores. The score sheets will be made available one week after the pageant.
- All contestants must submit official entry form to Gary Marion by 6pm of the day of the Pageant.
- By registering as a contestant, you agree, understand and except all rules.
- The winner will be responsible for:
 1. Being present at all events following the pageant during the week of Pride (Pride Parade/Pride Tea/etc.)
 2. 801 Will provide them with a car for the parade on that Sunday with a competent driver (no alcohol/illegal drugs/etc.), but will need to decorate their car to their choosing.
 3. You must attend (when available) all Key West Business Guild functions during the course of your reign.
 4. You must hold two (2) fund raisers during the course of your reign - one for the Key West Business Guild and one for the charity of your choice.
