## Social Media Policy

### Scope

- 1 In this policy, “**LSA social media accounts**” includes the Facebook page, the Instagram account and any other social media page or account that is controlled by one or more LSA council members and which presents itself as representing the LSA.

### Purpose

- 2 The purpose of this policy is to ensure the functional and respectful use of the LSA social media accounts.

### Content Moderation

- 3 (1) Content posted to ‘The Official U of S LSA Social Group’ Facebook page should be limited to content that is relevant or potentially relevant to a substantial portion of the Usask College of Law community.  
(2) In particular, content falling within the following categories is not allowed on LSA social media accounts:
  - (a) Non-college related solicitations, including for:
    - (i) [Repealed, February 2024]
    - (ii) Non-law volunteer or employment opportunities;
  - (b) Posts that are only relevant to an established subset of students such as members of a club or a particular year; and
  - (c) Posts that are clearly disrespectful or distasteful.
- (3) Any post made to ‘The Official U of S LSA Facebook Group’ that is not allowed will be removed.
- (4) The settings for ‘The Official U of S LSA Facebook Group’ shall not allow for anonymous posting or require prior approval for posts.

### Account Management

- 4 (1) The following LSA council members shall have management privileges for the LSA social media accounts:
  - (a) President;
  - (b) Vice-president of Academics;
  - (c) Vice-president of Administration.
  - (d) Vice-president of Athletics; and
  - (e) Vice-president of Social Relations;
- (2) In order to be admitted to the College of Law Alumni Facebook page, the applicant must be:
  - (a) A former University of Saskatchewan College of Law student;
  - (b) A current LSA Executive; or
  - (c) The current LSA Publicity Director.

### Conduct

- 5 All council members must maintain the highest standards of respect and integrity in the use of the LSA social media accounts.
