2024 By the Numbers

This past year, Angels on Patrol received an astounding 325 requests from law enforcement officers, translating into direct support for 4,108 individuals. This included 738 adults and 3,370 youth who received assistance during their most vulnerable moments. Since our founding, we have impacted 26,268 lives—a testament to the power of community and collaboration!
