When two children were unexpectedly displaced due to changes in their family situation, Phoenix Police Community Action Officers turned to Angels on Patrol to provide support during a difficult transition.

Together, we provided groceries and other essential items to help the children and the family members caring for them settle into their new living arrangement.

A Mesa Police School Resource Officer contacted Angels on Patrol after a student's bicycle was stolen from campus. By the very next day, we had replaced her bike so she could get to and from school.

Later, when the officer shared that she was graduating but lacked the resources to celebrate this important milestone, we stepped in once again. Excited to help her celebrate, we provided her graduation outfit, graduation photos, and personalized announcement cards - ensuring she could celebrate her graduation with confidence, joy, and memories that will last a lifetime.

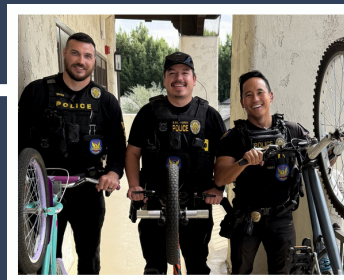
Building Positive Connections

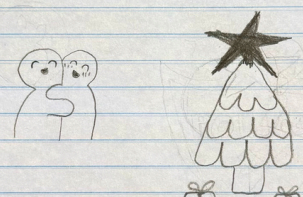
I am a kid and I love my bike. I want other kids to have a bike.
