This is our mission in action!

When an elderly man with medical and mental health challenges needed urgent help after his wife was hospitalized, officers from Apache Junction turned to us.

They utilized our after-hours card, which enabled us time to follow up and provide him with a safe place to stay and food until a long-term solution was found.

The total cost? \$489.68 — a small price to pay for the safety and well-being of this couple during their time of crisis.



After encountering a single mother and her children in need, an Apache Junction police officer felt compelled to help, so he placed a request to AoP.

A \$350 gift card to a grocery store was provided to help ease their burden.

An SRO from Mesa PD reached out after learning a student's bike was stolen, leaving him walking to school every day.

We stepped in and met up so he could pick out a new bike, helmet, and lock to ensure his safety as he goes to and from school each day!

Officers requested our help on a domestic violence call to get a young mom and her baby out of danger. Within 2 hours, we secured them a flight and they were on their way to safety with family.

A mom and her little one were spotted walking a long distance in the summer heat. The officers stopped to check if they were okay.

Turns out, her stroller had broken, and she couldn't afford a new one.

Thanks to their concern, we stepped in and delivered a stroller, diapers, and snacks to make things a bit easier for this single mom.



A Phoenix officer learned a student had been walking to and from school, over an hour each day, during the excessive heat in August.

He wanted to do something, and so he placed a request with us.

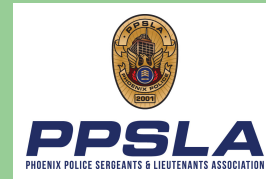
We are excited to once again host the Take Flight Golf Classic Tournament on Friday, December 6th, at Dobson Ranch in Mesa.

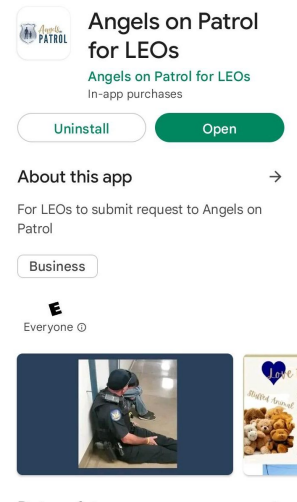


Update for Officers
