About Angels on Patrol

Angels on Patrol (AoP) is one of 21,137 non-profit organizations based in Arizona. Founded in 2009, by Phoenix Police Lt. Jacqui MacConnell, to be a direct resource for on-duty police officers. As an officer, Lt. MacConnell understands the barriers officers face while working to stabilize families in crisis. Officers are daily reaching into their own pockets as they assist victims of crime, domestic violence victims, families in crisis, and youth from at-risk communities. Angels on Patrol provides officers an opportunity to help above and beyond their duty.

What differentiates Angels on Patrol from the rest? AoP is the only non-profit organization serving the community through direct requests from law enforcement officers. Angels on Patrol has touched over 17,000 lives since its inception. The numbers continue to rise. From 2019 through November 2021, Angels on Patrol received 771 requests from officers, serving 4,795 individuals, during that time period.

Angels on Patrol currently serves 13 law enforcement agencies across the Valley and Maricopa County.

The unique service Angels on Patrol provides is critical for the community's most vulnerable, and for law enforcement officers, as they daily encounter people in crisis and in need of an immediate solution.
