# Inclusive Swim

1. This is a safe space for trans, non-binary, gender diverse, and gender-nonconforming people to enjoy a swimming day and use the changing facilities without fear of discrimination and cisnormative barriers. All people are welcome to use the changing facilities and bathrooms that they are comfortable in and that aligns with their gender identity and/or expression. Avoid commenting on anyone else's choice of change room or bathroom.



2. We are trans-centred, body-positive, fat-positive, and anti-racist. If you're joining the swim today please recognize that these core values will be upheld and act accordingly.

3. Avoid commenting on anyone's body for any reason and avoid unnecessary staring at people.



4. Ask for pronouns if you are uncertain to avoid misgendering anyone.



5. This swimming day is explicitly so that Trans people who are visibly gender non-conforming can feel comfortable in this space. There are no expectations about what you should look like in your swimming outfit or gender expression. All body shapes, sizes and types are welcome and celebrated in this space!

From sun protection, to safer substance use, Harm Reduction is all of our responsibility.

Make a plan, watch out for one another, and check out community resources.



**DID YOU KNOW** Heat related illnesses are the most common issue treated by first aid at Pride Events

#### **PACK AND PLAN**

- Sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, hand fan
- Snacks, electrolytes, water bottle
- Dental dams, lube, condoms, gloves
- Plan vour ride home
- Bus or cab fare
- Mask, hand sanitizer
- Comfortable shoes
- **Earplugs**
- Narcan



Don't use alone, buddy up. Start low, and go slow.

Consent is for more than just sex! Hugs, high fives, and everything between and beyond needs a consent check.

Check in with your friends to make sure they are playing safe and feeling comfortable.

Make sure your friends have a safe way home especially if they changed their plans near the end of the night. Get contact details and ask for a check-in if they are going home with a new cutie.

See someone looking uncomfortable, unsafe, or unwell? Check in with them and see if they need help.

suicide prevention training will have ASIST pins.

Support Buddies are available for those struggling with sobriety and needing support. They'll be wearing purple shirts and/or purple pins.

A Quiet Room is available for those needing less stimulation.

Paramedics are on scene in the event of an emergency.

Volunteers and Staff will be easily identifiable throughout the festival.

# Frequently Asked Questions



**No Smoking** inside the festival grounds, the designated smoking area is in the parking lot.



The Shipyard is a museum, so pets are not allowed in the festival.



The Ships are exhibits, there is **no food or beverage permitted on the ships**. Food and beverage may be consumed on the boardwalk or the grass.



**Uniformed Police Officers are not permitted.** We ask any police or bylaw officers attending to do so as a civilian and wear plain clothes.



**No outside alcohol allowed.** Alcohol may only be purchased and consumed in the designated area.



**Parking is limited.** Alternative parking can be found at RONA. We encourage folks without accessibility needs to park at RONA to allow those with needs to have parking at the Shipyard. Bus 91 will get you close to the event, get off by Save On Downtown!

In addition to the Gender Neutral Portable toilets, there are **accessible Gender Neutral washrooms** located inside the main building.

#### **SAFETY**

We have **private security** hired for the festival. Heritage Shipyard is **private property**, which allows us to control who is on the property. In the unlikely event of protestors they will be escorted off the property.

#### **EMERGENCY**
