



Enrichment Programming 2020-2021

LCA enrichment classes provide the perfect opportunity for your student to receive extra academic and homework support, as well as participate in fun and exciting enrichment options. Any of the classes below can be chosen à la carte as supplements to your child's basic academics. These are available T/W/Th from 1 - 4 pm, and Fridays from 9 am - 2 pm, except for weeks designated as LCA vacations or breaks. (Please refer to the school calendar.) They are available to currently enrolled LCA students, as well as other homeschool families in our area. **Enrichment classes may be purchased for the whole year or semester (13 weeks of sessions offered.)**

Fab Fridays! We are offering Friday classes as a whole FABULOUS day of extras at a discounted rate. **Fab Fridays are purchased as full days (9 am - 2 pm) for the whole year or semester.** The first semester includes the following Fridays: 9/4, 9/11, 9/18, 9/25, 10/2, 10/16, 10/23, 10/30, 11/6, 11/13, 11/20, 12/4, and 12/11.

Registration is \$50 per à la carte class (not to exceed \$150), and Fab Friday enrollment is \$150. (These registration fees do not apply to students already enrolled at LCA for core academic classes.) **First semester enrichment courses begin Sept. 1.**

Tutoring in Math and other subjects is available from 9 – 10 am on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, and from 2 – 3 pm or 3 – 4 pm on Thursdays.
