

CAMPERS MANUAL

CAMPER AGES

Camp Brynwood is for age 5-13
All campers must be able to swim without assistance.

CAMP DETAILS

Camp Brynwood offers 8 weeks of different themed camps. It is open to both members and non-members. Each day will have an ice-breaker, themed art, themed activity, snack time, sport (tennis, volleyball, soccer, kickball), lunch time, and swimming.

Camp runs from 9am - 3pm.

CAMP FEES:

Member weekly rate: \$150
Non-member weekly rate: \$175
Member daily rate: \$50
Non-member daily rate: \$65

REGISTRATION

Registration is open. Full payment is due upon registration.
Registration fee of \$25 includes 2 camp shirts.

ARRIVAL & PICK UP

Parents (or authorized guardian on their registration form) must check-in and check-out their child(ren) to camp everyday. This is for their safety so there will be no exceptions.

LUNCHES

Campers may pack a lunch each day or bring \$5 to purchase a lunch. Please be sure to let us know if you child has any food allergies.



WHAT TO PACK

Camp T-shirt must be worn each day at camp. Two shirts will be provided for you on the first day of camp. Additional shirts may be purchased for an additional \$12. Campers should dress in comfortable shorts and sneakers each day.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS SHOULD BE BROUGHT EACH DAY IN A BOOKBAG: flip flops for pool time, hat/cap, water bottle (labeled with child's name), sunscreen (labeled with child's name), swimsuit, towel, lunch or \$5 for lunch, and a snack.

DO NOT BRING: jewelry, electronic devices, items with sentimental value

CAMPER EXPECTATIONS

Parents, please discuss the following rules with your child before the start of the camp season.

1. Stay with your group and listen to your counselors at all times.
2. Be courteous with the words you use; inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
3. Be respectful of other's space and belongings.
4. Be respectful of your environment by throwing out all trash and returning equipment to its proper place after use.
5. Be a good sport whether you win or lose.

DISCIPLINE

Brynwood Swim Club reserves the right to dismiss any camper for inappropriate or unsafe behavior. The camp counselors will always make an effort to discuss and resolve any issues with a camper and their parents or guardian. If a problem persists and can not be connected, the camper will be dismissed and no refunds will be given.

ILLNESS & EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

If your child wakes up ill or has had a fever in the last 24 hours they must remain at home. If a child is injured or becomes ill during the camp day, you will be notified immediately and may be asked to pick up your child. In the unlikely event that an injury or illness requires emergency care, you will be notified immediately after the counselors have contacted 911. Paramedics will transport your child with an accompanying counselor to an emergency care facility. Parents or guardians will be responsible for any medical costs incurred.
