Below are the estimated costs for alterations. Prices are subject to vary based on fabric details (beading, lace, trim, horsehair ribbon, zippers, ruffles, godets, etc.)*

Rush Fees - Less than 1 week from initial fitting to vick up fitting - \$50

Wedding Press Rush Fees - Less than 4 weeks from initial fitting To vick up fitting \$75


-Mhat is Horsehair Ribbon?

Horsehair ribbon is a stiff synthetic material that, once upon a time, was made of horsehair added into hems.



-JJ)hat is a Godet?

A godet is a panel that is added into your skirt to give it more volume, depth, and swing. Commonly found in mermaid styled dresses and skirts.



- What is the preferred timing for alterations?

Non-Brides preferred lead time is 2-3 week minimum from the date of the event. Earlier is always better!
