How it's Possible: How Into The Spider Verse Was Animated

The animation Into the Spider Verse is mostly inspired by the look of anime and mangas as well as comic books. Into the Spider Verse had the largest crew for an animated movie which consisted of 140 animators. The animation to film process mostly consists of multiple steps:

- Kick off: The makers come up with concept ideas.
- **Script :** The agency knows the story they desire to tell better than anyone.
- **Design:** It's very helpful for them to get references from the start.
- Storyboard: It shows the building blocks of animation.
- **Animatic :** The purpose of animatic is to demonstrate timing, flow and pace.
- **Production:** They bring the story to life frame by frame.
- Sign Off and Feedback: They need approval of things first.
- Render: They provide a low resolution for an mp4 file.
- Final delivery: Delivering and rending can take some time but it will be worth the wait.

North Shore Animal League America has been rescuing homeless animals since it was founded in 1944. Their main location is in Port Washington, New York and they have 2,000 shelter partners across the country and all around the world. I am honored to be a part of this organization because I get to contribute to helping animals find a home. Who knows, maybe one day I can adopt a pet of my own from that place.


