Capybara's

The Capybara weighs between 75-150 pounds. Capybaras can get to an average length of 4 feet, and stand about 20 inches tall. Capybaras that live in South America and Chile and Ecuador. Capybaras eat grass and water plants. They are also known as water hog carpinchos. Capybaras swim in water with webbed feet. They can dive down to the bottom of a lake or river to find plants and stay there for up to five minutes. They are strictly vegetation and have been known to raid gardens for melons and squash.
