






## Words Of Wisdom

### Discovery by Hudson

If you are like me, then you probably love going out to experience all that New York City has to offer. However, it may surprise you to learn that before any of us got to enjoy the shining lights of Broadway, the isle of Manhattan was first discovered by Henry Hudson on September 4, 1609. Henry Hudson was an English sea explorer and navigator. The Hudson River is even named after him. Hudson made two attempts on behalf of English merchants to find the rumored northeast passage to present-day China using a route above the Arctic Circle in 1607 or 1608. However, they were unsuccessful. He finally discovered New York in 1609. He sailed up the Hudson River and thereby laid the foundation for Dutch colonization of the region. Hudson discovered The Hudson Strait and the immense Hudson Bay on his final expedition while still searching for the Northwest Passage.

Hudson wasn't the first person to set foot on the isle of Manhattan. The area that is now Manhattan was long inhabited by the Lenape people. The groups of culturally and linguistically identical Native Americans in the region traditionally spoke an Algonquian language now referred to as Unami. The next time you visit Manhattan and are taking a stroll along the Hudson River, remember that Henry Hudson arrived on that same river all the way back in September 1609!
