#### Are You Sure ... About Heaven?

- #1 You are a sinner. Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." God says that everyone has done something against His wishes. This is sin. Only God is perfect and without sin. Search your heart. You will see the things that God sees.
- #2 There is a Penalty for Sin. Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." God says we all have sinned and earned the punishment of death. One day your body will die and your soul (the real you) will go to live forever with either a Holy God in Heaven or with the Devil in the torture of Hell. God's will is that no one suffers in Hell but that everyone receives His gift of eternal life which is freely available to you through Jesus Christ.
- #3 Jesus Christ Has Paid for Your Sins. Romans 5:8 "For God commended His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." God proved His love for us by sending His only begotten Son to pay our sin penalty. Jesus Christ led a sinless life, yet He willingly laid down His life as a perfect sacrifice for us. Have you ever seen a picture of Jesus on the cross? Jesus let them nail His hands and feet to the cross and God the Father placed all your past, present and future sins on Him. He died with all your sin on Him so you may live with Him in Heaven. Would you like that?
- #4 Ask Jesus Now Romans 10:13 "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." This verse is God's promise that if you believe Jesus is God's Son who died to pay for your sins, God will hear you and save you instantly. Will you ask Jesus to be your Savior? Right now pray this simple prayer...




