Dedicated Journey of Growth

2022:

Tyrone made an impressive mark on the sport by finishing 2nd in the three- round Florida Winter Series in the Micro Rok class. That same year, he achieved a historic double victory, winning the World Karting Association championships in both Mini Swift and L206 classes.

2023:

Tyrone's rapid growth posed unique challenges, as his size outgrew the limitations of his kart chassis at just 10 years old. This prompted a move to the next class, competing against drivers aged 13-16 on full-size 100cc chassis. Although national series regulations barred him from racing at his age, Tyrone dominated club- level competition.

2024:

At the age of 11, Tyrone's exceptional talent earned him an age waiver to compete in the Regional Texas Sprint Racing Series. He didn't just participate—he excelled, winning the five-race KA100 Jr. championship and claiming the prestigious International Kart Federation (IKF) Grand National title, the historic Duffy trophy.

2025:

Tyrone Kemper Jr. continues to prove himself as a rising talent in competitive karting. He completed the prestigious 4-round SKUSA Winter Series at Orlando Kart Center in the KA100 Jr. class, securing an impressive 8th place overall out of a 76-driver field—demonstrating consistency and pace among the nation's top young racers.

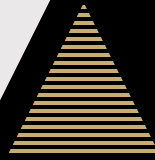
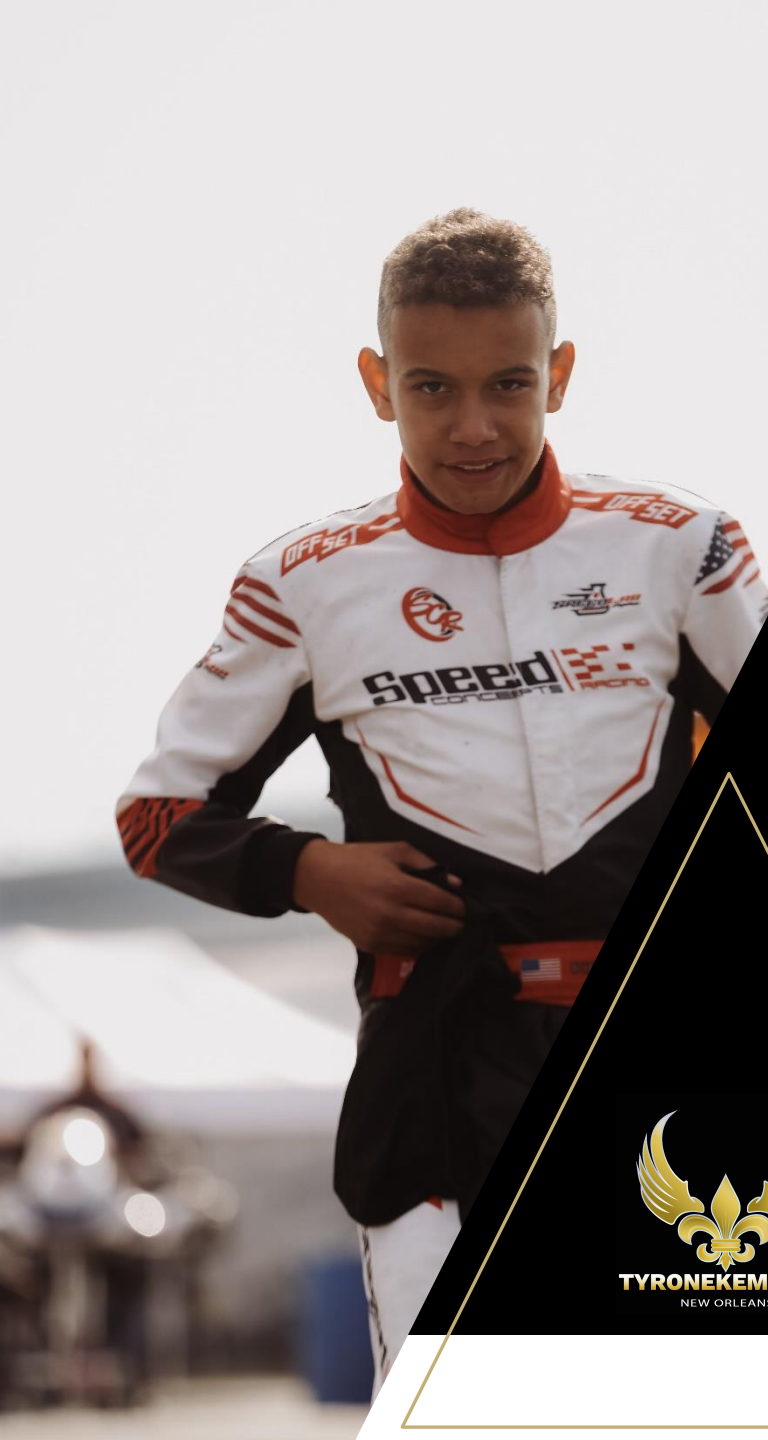
