AP1	Deliver solutions that add value early and continuously.	Our highest priority is to satisfy the customer through early and continuous delivery of valuable software.
AP2	Welcome change as it is a source for our customer's competitive advantage.	Welcome changing requirements, even late in development. Agile processes harness change for the customer's competitive advantage.
AP3	Deliver value in shorter time spans – better able to assess and correct.	Deliver working software frequently, from a couple of weeks to a couple of months, with a preference to the shorter timescale.
AP4	People must work together daily in a collaborative manner throughout the project. (Management, employees, consultants)	Business people and developers must work together daily throughout the project.
AP5	Motivate and empower teams. Provide them with the environment and support they need, and trust them to get the job done.	Build projects around motivated individuals. Give them the environment and support they need, and trust them to get the job done.
AP6	Eliminate communication barriers – face-to-face communication is the best.	The most efficient and effective method of conveying information to and within a development team is face-to-face conversation.
AP7	Working solution is the primary measure of progress.	Working software is the primary measure of progress.
AP8	Agile processes promote sustainable business results.	Agile processes promote sustainable development. The sponsors, developers, and users should be able to maintain a constant pace indefinitely.
AP9	Continuous attention to excellence and good design enhances agility/business results.	Continuous attention to technical excellence and good design enhances agility.
AP10	Simplicity--the art of maximizing the amount of work not done--is essential.	Simplicity--the art of maximizing the amount of work not done--is essential.
AP11	The best solutions and ideas emerge from self-organizing teams.	The best architectures, requirements, and designs emerge from self-organizing teams.
