New-believer questions with encouraging KJV Scripture responses.

What if I sin after baptism?

1 John 1:9 (KJV)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

What if I do not feel different?

2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV)

Therefore if any man [be] in Christ, [he is] a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Do I have to be perfect?

Philippians 1:6 (KJV)

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [it] until the day of Jesus Christ:

What if I fail?

Proverbs 24:16 (KJV)

For a just [man] falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

Can God still forgive me?

Psalms 103:12 (KJV)

As far as the east is from the west, [so] far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

Why am I still struggling with temptation?

1 Corinthians 10:13 (KJV)

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

What if I do not understand the Bible?

James 1:5 (KJV)

If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all [men] liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

How do I hear God's voice?

John 10:27 (KJV)

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Is it okay to question God?

Jeremiah 33:3 (KJV)

Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

What if I stop praying?

Hebrews 4:16 (KJV)

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

What if I miss reading my Bible?

Psalm 119:105 (KJV)

NUN. Thy word [is] a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Do I really need church?

Hebrews 10:24-25 (KJV)

And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some [is]; but exhorting [one another]: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Should I stop hanging around old friends?

1 Corinthians 15:33 (KJV)

Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

What if my family does not support my faith?

Psalm 27:10 (KJV)

When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.

What is the Holy Spirit?

John 14:26 (KJV)

But the Comforter, [which is] the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Why should I forgive?

Ephesians 4:32 (KJV)

And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

How do I know God's will?

Romans 12:2 (KJV)

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

How do I overcome fear?

2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV)

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

What if I backslide?

Proverbs 24:16 (KJV)

For a just [man] falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

Can I come back to God?

James 4:8 (KJV)

Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse [your] hands, [ye] sinners; and purify [your] hearts, [ye] double minded.

Which Bible should I read?

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (KJV)

All scripture [is] given by inspiration of God, and [is] profitable

for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.
