The undersigned member/shooter agrees to observe all Camp Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to the safe t premises:

1. No loaded firearms shall be brought into the club house or onto the grounds. Valid CCW/CHL Permit/License holders may carry as the law allows as permitted by their CCW/CHL.
2. When carrying a firearm onto a shooting field the firearm is to remain unloaded with the action open until the shooter is on the shooting line or shooting station ready to shoot, and it is safe to discharge the firearm. Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are pointing the firearm in a safe direction and ready to fire. In the event of a misfire, or jamming of a firearm, do not attempt to clear the firearm until it is safe to do so, and in a manner which ensures the safety of the shooter and other shooters in the field.
3. Adequate Eye and Hearing Protection must be worn at all times when on a shooting field.
4. Never point a firearm at anything other than an approved target with an appropriate backstop or background.
5. All Posted Rifle - Pistol Range Rules are to be followed.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK / RELEASE / INDEMNIFICATION OF CLAIMS

Although GSC takes all necessary and reasonable precautions and steps to provide for the safety of all participants in the shooting sports, the use of firearms and recreational shooting is an ultra-hazardous activity for which the participant assumes the risk of personal injury and damage inherent in this activity. The undersigned is personally responsible for adhering to all Camp Rules, Regulations and the safe handling and discharge of all firearms. Any minor or participant of whom have little or no experience in recreational shooting, must be strictly supervised by an experienced shooter and club member.

The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has read the above, and in consideration for using the Camp's Shooting Facilities, agrees to all of the terms and conditions herein, and agree to be responsible for any and all damages to the Camp Facilities arising out of his/her conduct, acts or omissions, and that he/she will indemnify and hold harmless Greenville Camp Mercer County Sportsman Association, Inc., its officers, directors, agents and employees against any and all claims, damages, loss and liability arising out of his/her intentional or negligent acts or omissions on the Camp's premises. Greenville Camp Mercer County Sportsmen Association, Inc. is not responsible for lost or stolen property on the premises. All persons shall take care and precaution to safeguard their possessions and property while on the premises.

The undersigned also affirms and acknowledges the he/she is not prohibited under any Federal, State or Local law and/or any Court Order from possessing or handling firearms.

PISTOL RANGE RULES**

Members must READ and INTITIAL acknowledging each of the individual range rules listed below and SIGN at the bottom of form.

- ___ Rifle and pistol ranges are for use by MEMBERS and family members (as described in the Club's By-Laws)
Members must be 18 years of age, or have direct parental supervision. **'GUESTS' ARE NOT PERMITTED**
- ___ Shooting hours, 10am until dusk - no shooting before 10am or after dusk.
- ___ No automatic weapons to be used.
- ___ No rapid fire of semi-automatics.
- ___ The range is closed on Easter and Christmas day.
- ___ No random shooting. All shots are to be at posted targets on the target backers.
- ___ While shooting on the 75, 100 and 200 yard range, no shots to be less than 75 yards. Utilize 25 and 50 yard ranges for shooting distances less than 75 yards.
- ___ The lower range gate is to be UNLOCKED AND OPEN at all times while on the property and/or while shooting.
Close and lock gate when leaving the range and no one else is on the grounds (last one out).
- ___ Each member is responsible for removing his/her own targets and his/her own debris that may have been brought to the range. Police ALL brass. Take all trash with you when done shooting.
- ___ No alcoholic beverages permitted on GSC grounds.

Rules Specific to 10-yard Range:

- ___ DO NOT intentionally shoot steel plate on target stand.
- ___ DO NOT intentionally shoot at or attach targets to railroad tie border.
- ___ 10-yard range is to be used for pistol caliber and smaller firearms only.
- ___ PROHIBITED Rifle calibers (.556/.223, etc.) and shotgun loads. Use 25 and 50 yard ranges for rifle calibers and shotgun loads.
- ___ Targets/backstops are to be attached to top horizontal wire using binder clips, tape or clothespins. Members

should come prepared with their own supplies. There are two additional horizontal wires for securing targets/backstops from moving. DO NOT shoot horizontal target wires.

____ Please take all backstop materials you bring for your own use, home with you. Do not leave trash on range or GSC grounds.

VIOLATION OF THESE RULES OR MISUSE OF THE GROUNDS MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has read the above Rifle and Pistol Range Rules and agree to abide by them at all times while utilizing Greenville Camp facilities.
