**RIFLE and PISTOL RANGE RULES**

**Members must READ and INTITIAL acknowledging each of the individual range rules listed below and SIGN at the bottom of form.**

- \_\_\_ Rifle and pistol ranges are for use by MEMBERS and family members (as described in the Club's By-Laws) or SUPERVISED GSC Firearms classes ONLY. Members must be 18 years of age, or have direct parental supervision. **'GUESTS' ARE NOT PERMITTED**
- \_\_\_ Shooting hours, 10 am until dusk - no shooting before 10 am or after dusk.
- \_\_\_ No automatic weapons to be used.
- \_\_\_ No rapid fire of semi-automatics.
- \_\_\_ The range is closed on Easter and Christmas day.
- \_\_\_ No random shooting. All shots are to be at posted targets on the target backers.
- \_\_\_ While shooting on the 75, 100 and 200 yard range, no shots to be less than 75 yards. Utilize 25 and 50 yard ranges for shooting distances less than 75 yards.
- \_\_\_ The lower range gate is to be UNLOCKED AND OPEN at all times while on the property and/or while shooting. Close and lock gate when leaving the range and no one else is on the grounds (last one out).
- \_\_\_ Each member is responsible for removing his/her own targets and his/her own debris that may have been brought to the range. Police ALL brass. Take all trash with you when done shooting.
- \_\_\_ No alcoholic beverages permitted on GSC grounds.

**Rules Specific to 10-yard Range:**

- \_\_\_ DO NOT intentionally shoot steel plate on target stand.
- \_\_\_ DO NOT intentionally shoot at or attach targets to railroad tie border.
- \_\_\_ 10-yard range is to be used for pistol caliber and smaller firearms only.
- \_\_\_ PROHIBITED Rifle calibers (.556/.223, etc.) and shotgun loads. Use 25 and 50 yard ranges for rifle calibers and shotgun loads.
- \_\_\_ Targets/backstops are to be attached to top horizontal wire using binder clips, tape or clothespins. Members should come prepared with their own supplies. There are two additional horizontal wires for securing targets/backstops from moving. DO NOT shoot horizontal target wires.
- \_\_\_ Please take all backstop materials you bring for your own use, home with you. Do not leave trash on range or GSC grounds.

**VIOLATION OF THESE RULES OR MISUSE OF THE GROUNDS MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP**
