Rules and Regulations

All dogs must have up-to-date age appropriate health vaccinations, specifically: Rabies, DHLLP, Parvo and Bordetella. In addition, heartworm treatment and flea/tick treatment is required to protect the health of your dog. All dogs must be in good health and have been free of any potentially harmful illnesses that may affect other guests.

Spay/Neuter:

All dogs **four months** and older are required to be spayed/neutered. **No exceptions.**

Leash/Collar:

All dogs must have a choke, martingale or no slip collar with an ID tag which includes an emergency contact number and a leash in case of an emergency.

Food and Toys/Special Items:

All food items must be stored in bag with instructions for administering. Any dogs that require special food due to dietary needs must provide food upon arrival. Lucy's Dog Daycare will not provide special dietary food.

Toys and/or special play items will not be permitted.

Enrollment:

All dogs are required to have up-to-date New Member Forms. Any dog that has not attended Lucy's Dog Daycare for more than four months is required a new entrance assessment. All forms must be signed by responsible party prior to enrollment. Proof of required vaccinations must be provided at first visit. Expired vaccinations will require proof of renewal.

Fees:

Fees are due at the end of each day unless a pre - paid package has been purchased. Payments can be made in cash, check, credit card, or PayPal.

Reservations:

No reservations are needed for daycare. Reservations are required for boarding.

Hours of Operation:

Doors are open 6:30 AM to 10 AM and 3 PM to 7 PM.
Saturday and Sunday daycare is by appointment only (call first)

Enrollment Acknowledgement

I acknowledge and understand that participating in Lucys Dog Daycare dogs may be exposed to the outdoors and other dogs. If my dog shows symptom of sickness (runny stool, Fever, excessive mucus) we will keep him home that day. I understand that some sicknesses are to be expected as well as parasites such as fleas are possible. I understand Lucy's requires heartworm and flea prevention to avoid most issues. I understand I may be required to pick my dog up early if brought to daycare with symptoms.

I acknowledge and understand that participating in Lucys Dog Daycare activities may cause sore muscles, sore joints, and fatigue to dogs not used to the level of activity provided. Dogs that are not exposed to outside play may experience sore paws, blisters, bruises, or abrasions on the feet.

I acknowledge and understand that participating in Lucys Dog Daycare may cause my dogs to get dirty or matted. Any dogs with long toenails will be requested to be trimmed prior to next attendance. Any dogs with fleas will not be permitted to attend daycare until proof of flea preventative is provided.

I acknowledge and understand that participating in Lucys Dog Daycare carries a certain level of risk. At Lucy's we do a very strict screening process and do the best to keep all our members safe from any harm. We don't allow aggressive animals into the program. If any animal ever displays aggressive behaviors they will be removed from the program.

Lucys Dog Daycare has full power of decision making in regards to the care and well-being of my dogs. Should a medical emergency arise, I agree that the staff of Lucys Dog Daycare can and will make any necessary decisions concerning medical treatment and choice caregiver with a maximum amount of \$_____ and I will be responsible for reimbursement of all costs associated with the treatment.
