Attached you will find the new bidding guidelines to host our regional convention known as the AVCNA.

We, the Virginia Regional Convention Corporation, Inc., would like to share with you a few thoughts that prompted the recent changes voted into policy 2024. As fiduciaries of the AVCNA, we discussed ideas that would be beneficial to the continued annual celebration of recovery known as the AVCNA. One of those ideas was to return every 3 years to the same location. The locations of Richmond, VA, Roanoke, VA and the Hampton Roads locations in VA are the chosen locations.

Another idea supporting the 3-yr. rotation was to develop a long-standing relationship with the same hotel in each city. Because of these changes, the need for a hotel fact finding sheet is no longer a requirement. The VRCC, Inc. will secure the hotel now.

Each year the Areas in the Central Atlantic Region will receive written communication from the board notifying them of the location and the hotel for the next bidding convention. We invite you to send a director to serve on the board if your Area does not currently have this position filled.

## New AVCNA Rotation Bidding Guidelines

The AVCNA will rotate every 3 years between the geographical locations of Hampton Roads, VA, Richmond, VA and Roanoke, VA. The convention hotels will be selected by the VRCC. Any Area of the Central Atlantic Region can host the AVCNA in these locations. The following are guidelines to be completed to bid for the AVCNA. If (2) Areas would like to co-host, each co-hosting Area would need to complete these guidelines.

1. An Area group conscience in favor of hosting the AVCNA.
2. An Area letter of support from a surrounding Area to host the AVCNA.
3. Areas bidding for the AVCNA are to notify the VRCC of their intention in the March VRCC meeting, 22 months before said AVCNA.
4. All bids must be completed and submitted in the May VRCC meeting, 20 months before the AVCNA.
5. VRCC will ask for a Director's vote to accept the bid in the May VRCC meeting.
6. Any complete bids not accepted will be held for the following year.

For the 43<sup>rd</sup> AVCNA to be held in January 2027, the location is Virginia Beach, VA. The Hotel is the Founders Inn. Bids are due at the May 2025 meeting of the VRCC. If you would like more information, please contact us at [www.avcna.org](http://www.avcna.org).




