Why Mobile Libraries Matter

Did you know studies show that mobile library services and mobile/digital library tools significantly increase access to learning, especially in communities with limited internet or library access? For example:

- A study in Karnataka, India found that mobile library services improved user engagement, awareness, and regular reading habits.
- Research on mobile technology in library services reveals mobile devices like phones and tablets can make accessing information easier, more instant, and more cost-effective for many users.

These kinds of services help bridge the digital divide, support literacy, and open up educational opportunities something we see first-hand with MiLa in our HUB.

HER Essentials with Girl Flow 🌼



On September 20, 2025, A Brighter Day Outreach partnered with Girl Flow to host HER Essentials—a special program designed to empower girls ages 9 to 16 with confidence, knowledge, and the tools they need to thrive.

The event featured:

- Free essentials kits tailored for young girls

- Workshops on self-care, personal growth, and empowerment

This partnership was especially meaningful as it brought together two Unite Charlotte Alumni–Tashina Figueroa, Founder and Executive Director of Girl Flow, and Beverly Knox Davis, Founder and President of A Brighter Day Outreach.



Upcoming Community Give-Back 2025!


Mark your calendars! A Brighter Day Outreach is excited to announce our next Community Give-Back Event, happening on October 18, 2025 at the Community HUB.

Our homeless families need essential hygiene items, including washcloths, soap, combs, lotion, toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, and hand sanitizer. Your donations can make a real difference in helping those in need maintain their dignity and well-being.

Additionally, we're working alongside the Historic Hoskins Coalition Group, which celebrated its 4th year of service to the community last February 2025, to complete the Historic Hoskins



Community Identity Project. Only four entryway signs remain to complete—two for Historic Hoskins Community and one each for North Hoskins and South Hoskins. Aside from that, our Historic Hoskins Community Mobile Mural has become a beloved symbol of neighborhood pride and history but it has taken a weather beating from Hurricane Helene and several storms earlier this year.

Weather and a budget constrained build has led to needing a lasting solution. A durable solution has been presented at a cost of \$40,000. This solution will allow for a durable product and digitized artwork. This repair will allow for this structure to last for decades to come.

Every dollar helps us fix and maintain this mural that tells the story of our people, our culture, and our strength.
