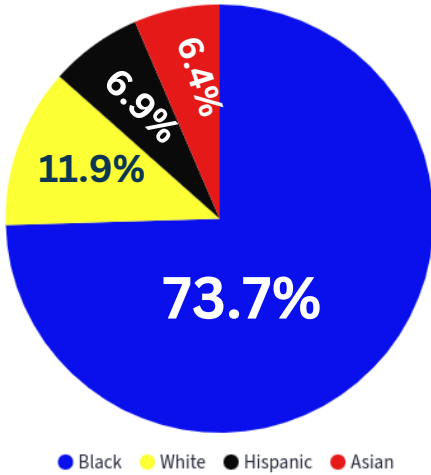


WHY A PLACE-BASED APPROACH IN THE HISTORIC HOSKINS COMMUNITY?
