	<p><b>Sefer Yirmiyahu Perek 36 Pasuk 23 - Perek 37 Pasuk 21.</b> This week's learning included King Yehoyakim tearing up the scroll and burning it in the fire pit. Yirmiyahu and Baruch were not found by the royal guards because they were in hiding. Hashem instructed Yirmiyahu to dictate a new scroll to Baruch. This event took place during the reign of king Tzidkiyah. Tzidkiyah sent two messengers to Yirmiyahu asking Yirmiyahu to pray on his behalf. Yirmiyahu sent back a prophecy that related that only Hashem can save, and no other. Bavel's army retreated after hearing the possibility that the Egyptian army might fight against them. Yirmiyahu fled to the region of Binyamin. A guard in Binyamin's territory accused Yirmiyahu of colluding with Nevuchadnetzar. Yirmiyahu denied the accusation. Yirmiyahu was beaten and thrown into a pit. Tzidkiyah sent for Yirmiyahu. Yirmiyahu pleaded for his life and begged not to be returned to the pit. Tzidkiyah agreed to the request and kept Yirmiyahu confined to a courtyard with a guard.
