- 3. Offering Practice (leaving on Greeters Table or circulating) move offering plate into sanctuary on table behind pew.
- 4. Lifting floor tape and resuming leaving by south and side entrance. yes
- 5. Wearing Masks (as of March 21 it will not be mandated in Ontario) encouraged to continue to wear mask
- When to resume speaking and singing during Worship table to April. Hum along.
- 7. Resuming Choir 4-5 willing to sing beginning in April. Looking at Palm Sunday.
- 8. Distribution of communion (continue using prepackaged communion and individual pick up) yes next Communion Easter. Pick up at door.
- 9. Return of Hymn Books and Bibles put back in April when singing resumes
