

DECLARATION OF STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER

City of Bevil Oaks, Texas



WHEREAS, Whereas the City of Bevil Oaks on or about the 5th of July, 2024 the Acting Governor of the State of Texas, Dan Patrick, issued a disaster proclamation certifying that Hurricane Beryl poses a threat of imminent disaster, including widespread and severe property damage, injury, and loss of life due to widespread flooding, life-threatening storm surge, damage wind and heavy rainfall including but not limited to Jefferson County, Texas, the City of Bevil Oaks on the 7th of July 2024 hereby also issues a disaster proclamation for these reasons; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Bevil Oaks has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED BY THE MAYOR OF BEVIL OAKS, TEXAS, that:

- 1.) That a state of local disaster is hereby declared for the City of Bevil Oaks pursuant to 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code;
- 2.) Pursuant to 418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Bevil Oaks.
- 3.) Pursuant to 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
- 4.) Pursuant to 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City Emergency Management Plan. This declaration further activates the recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the Declaration, and the preparedness and response aspects of the plans are activated as provided in the plans;
- 6.) The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Declaration are severable and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Declaration should be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court or competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Declaration that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this Order are severable.
- 7.) This Declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Jefferson County; and
- 8.) This Declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
