

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF BEVIL OAKS

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN BUILDINGS OR ON PROPERTIES BELONGING TO THE TOWN OF BEVIL OAKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEVIL OAKS:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or consume any vinous, spirituous or malt liquors or alcoholic beverages within any town building or town properties, or upon any town street or sidewalk.

SECTION 2.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined in any sum not to exceed the sum of TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$200.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION 3.

The town clerk is ordered and directed to make publication of this ordinance ten (10) days at three public places within the corporate limits of the Town, and upon completion of said publication to certify, in the place provided below, that said publication has been made; and upon completion of this certificate, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect.

PASSED this the 16 day of December, A. D., 1975, by an affirmative vote of Five or more of the Board of Aldermen.
