HAVE YOU SEEN THE CLEARING?

Many citizens have been asking about the clearing that has taken place behind the City Hall and whether or not some project is about to begin. The City has been asking DD6 for some time to clear that area along a major drainage ditch so that it can be maintained for proper drainage. In addition, DD6 also cleared the easement for another drainage ditch on River Bend at Wayside that runs west thru the woods to River Road. DD6 plans to clean out the bottom of the ditch that runs thru the woods soon as it has silted in and is preventing proper drainage in the River Bend area.

At this time, there are no plans for any type of construction along the ditch behind City Hall which is on land that is owned by the City of Bevil Oaks. A citizen has volunteered to cleanup the debris left by the clearing operation as DD6 does not perform this operation. There has been some talk of a possible park or walking paths, however, the money does not exist at this time to perform this work. Citizens are encouraged to make suggestions on land use as well as ideas on how to fund such a project.

ARE YOU PREPARED?

Dear Resident:

Once again we are in the heart of hurricane season. As many who have lived in the area very long know, this is the time that most hurricanes form and/or hit our area. Fortunately, we have continued to dodge any more hurricanes since the 2009 season. However, we never know how long this good luck streak will continue to last, and the best we can do is be prepared.

We encourage each home owner to make the following preparations, if not already:

Purchase a flood insurance policy

Make a flood plan and review it with everyone in the household; this includes evacuation routes, important information that should be kept in a waterproof/fireproof place, and any supplies you may need. Don't forget about your pets!

Review your current insurance policy and become familiar with what is, and what is not covered Itemize and take pictures of your possessions

To assist you in evaluating your insurance coverages, FEMA has produced an informational piece titled *Flood Insurance: How it Works*. You can view it online at http://www.fema.gov/media-library-data/1381428240157-1080f725cb637be06fde2219950777b1/FS_HowFloodInsuranceWorks_092013.pdf or at the City Hall. We hope this will be helpful to you.

Upon final approval of the proposed Flood Insurance Rate Map for the City of the Bevil Oaks, some of our residents will be moved from flood zone "X" to special flood hazard area "AE."
