

ORDINANCE NO. 226

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CURRENT TEXAS BOARD OF HEALTH
"RULES ON FOOD SERVICES SANITATION" AND TO DESIGNATE THE
HEALTH AUTHORITY OF JEFFERSON COUNTY AS HEALTH
AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BEVIL OAKS, TEXAS:**


SECTION 1. Subject to the applicable provisions of the State law and Jefferson County, therein is hereby approved and adopted an ordinance adopting the current Texas Board of Health "Rules on Food Services Sanitation",

to designate the Health Authority of Jefferson County as Health Authority for the purposes of this Ordinance, to require all food service establishments, retail food stores, mobile food units, and roadside food vendors within the corporate limits to maintain a valid health permit,


to adopt health permit fees as established by Commissioners' Court in unincorporated areas of the County for each food establishment and for each temporary food establishment, to assign to the Jefferson County Health Authority to collect health fees directly from permit applicants.

SECTION 2. The City shall be responsible for enforcement of the City's health ordinance.
