

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A MARSHAL BY THE MAYOR AND CONFIRMED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BEVIL OAKS, TEXAS, PROVIDING A TERM OF OFFICE, AND POWERS AND DUTIES OF SAID MARSHAL

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bevil Oaks, Texas, finds that it is to the best interest of the citizens of the City of Bevil Oaks for the Mayor of said City to appoint the City Marshall and said appointment be confirmed by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bevil Oaks; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bevil Oaks, Texas, finds, that it is to the best interest of the City of Bevil Oaks that the City Marshal no longer be an elected city official; therefore,  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BEVIL OAKS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Article 977, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, the office of Marshal of the City of Bevil Oaks shall hereafter be filled by appointment of the Mayor of the City of Bevil Oaks and confirmation of said appointment by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bevil Oaks.


Section 2. The Marshal of the City of Bevil Oaks, Texas shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Compensation for the Marshal shall be as determined by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

Section 3. The Marshal of the City of Bevil Oaks, Texas shall have all of the powers and duties of a Marshal as provided in Article 999, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes and such other powers and duties as may be provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
