In preparation for our annual audit coming up for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2014, I contacted several auditing firms to see if they would submit a proposal.

Here is the outcome, with more details to be given at the meeting:

| Wathen DeShong & Juncker | \$14,080 | The only official proposal received as requested from all firms; mentioned a multi-year contract |
| Cook Parker | N/A | Stated they could do it, but would not have time to do a proposal this year; however, keep them in mind for later years; also stated they would probably require a multi-year contract, and would be higher than our current cost of \$12,500 |
| Edwards & Associates | N/A | Spoke to them before sending request; they do governmental audits; sent request letter; still no response for official proposal; left message with them again |

Several of the ones I spoke too, including Wathen DeShong & Juncker, stated most auditing firms now require multi-year contracts or the costs increase dramatically. I will discuss details of those calls at the meeting.
