Boil Water Notice Rescinded July 04, 2024

On July 01, 2024, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Bevil Oaks public water system, PWS1230049, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees **for those living in Vautrot's trailer park (13350 Hwy 105) along with Vautrot's Cajun Cuisine,** that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of July 04,2024.
