Boil Water Notice Rescinded April 12, 2024

On **April 08, 2024** the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Bevil Oaks public water system, PWS1230049, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees <u>for those living on Davida, Craig lane,</u> <u>Saddlewood Court and the following homes on River Oaks Blvd: 13255,</u> <u>13285,13325,13345,13365,13385, and13425</u>, that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of **April 12, 2024**.
