Public Notice Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation Operational Evaluation Report

The **CITY OF BEVIL OAKS** PWS ID **1230049** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems in exceedance of an operational evaluation level are required to conduct an evaluation of their source water, treatment and distribution operations and submit a report of their findings to the TCEQ.

We failed to conduct an operational evaluation and/or submit a report to the TCEQ.

What is being done?

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

We have provided our OEL report to TCEQ in a timely manner and returned to compliance as of 05/29/2018 but must now post this notice to be in compliance with the program area.

Hurricane Harvey hit our area in August of 2017 and higher disinfection was required to properly disinfect the system. In turn TTHM increased due to low water use causing high water age.
