

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVIL OAKS, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE FOR THE DISASTER RECOVERY FUND, HURRICANE IKE, ROUND 2.2; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY 'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bevil Oaks desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and


WHEREAS, the City Council supports and affirmatively furthers fair housing; and

WHEREAS, the City needs funds to recover from damage and failure to function during and after Hurricane Ike;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Bevil Oaks, TEXAS:.

1. That a Community Development Block Grant Program Application for the Disaster Recovery Fund, Hurricane Ike, Round 2.2 is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas General Land Office.
2. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City 's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City 's participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program, Disaster Recovery Fund, Hurricane Ike, Round 2.2.
