We're located in the Jefferson County, with a population of approximately 1250 residents. We have a Mayor, 6 Councilmen, 2 office staff, a city attorney and a city municipal judge. We have monthly council meetings at the City Hall, located at 13560 River Oaks Blvd, on the 3RD Thursday of the month. You are always welcome to attend. Our residents pay city taxes to Jefferson County, and school taxes to Hardin County. All addresses are listed as Beaumont, even though we are our own little city.
