

The City of Bevil Oaks Public Works department is aware that many citizens are facing significant challenges due to the economic interruptions caused by the coronavirus emergency. Effective as of March 19, 2020, the City will not discontinue water service for a period of forty-five days for account holders who demonstrate significant financial hardship. A written statement is required. The City Council will continue to monitor the current state of public health emergency to determine whether to extend this period. Nonetheless, the Public Works department is required by City Ordinance to charge for water service and to keep a record of fees, including late fees, incurred by users. Accordingly, the City strongly advises users to continue making payments on their accounts and to communicate with the Public Works department through these challenging times.
