- 1. Must follow current Precinct and County policies
- 2. County will provide the labor and fill dirt needed for installation of a culvert at no cost
- 3. Precinct 1 requires a minimum culvert length of 20 feet and a maximum length of 40 feet
- 4. Culverts must be purchased by the customer/homeowner and onsite before installation begins. Site should be staked for proper installation
- 5. After installation, to protect your new culvert, we recommend that you cover your newly installed culvert with mats, heavy plywood, or something to distribute weight until the material has had time to settle. This should help prevent your culvert from being damaged
- 6. Any relocation of a culvert will have a minimum charge of \$400.00 and is the responsibility of the customer/homeowner
- 7. Concrete driveway foundation framing must be inspected by Jefferson County Pct. 1 Road & Bridge BEFORE concrete is poured over culverts
- 8. Should a culvert cause issues such as flooding, sole discretion lies with Jefferson County to remove offending culvert. This cost is the responsibility of the customer/homeowner
- 9. Cost of maintenance of the culvert and material around the culvert will be the responsibility of the customer/ homeowner
- 10. Customer/Homeowner will be responsible for maintaining the driveway
