WHEREAS, the City of Bevil Oaks City Council approved to create a cap on water rates for <u>residential</u> primary meter usage over 7500 gallons. This will result in reducing the cost per gallon over 7500 gallons from \$0.026 per gallon to \$0.013 per gallon for <u>residential primary meters usage only</u>. This reduction effectively eliminates sewer fees for water usage over 7500 gallons.

BE IT RESOLVED, the utility department shall adjust the rates charged for water rates for monthly water usage for residential primary meters to 7500 gallons. Eligible consumers shall not be charged for water usage over 7500 gallons but shall be responsible for all other duly incurred charges.
