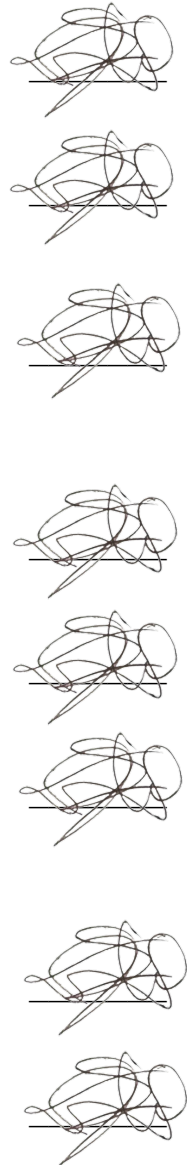

Pledge for Liberty

Libertarian Party of Colorado

1. In order to make life more affordable in Colorado, I will vote against tax increases, vote to lower current taxes and will vote to eliminate the state income tax.
2. I will stand up for excellence in learning by promoting school choice and the freedom of families to make their own educational decisions.
3. I will fully defend the Taxpayer Bill of Rights (TABOR) and do everything in my power to protect it, including voting against any legislation that would use refunds for buying votes.
4. In order to make housing more affordable, I will vote to lower property tax assessment rates, return taxes to local control and support any effort to lower property taxes, including directing the Attorney General to investigate unlawful over-collection of taxes.
5. In order to provide better and more affordable healthcare, I will support deregulating the medical marketplace.
6. I will support an audit of the State Government and its use of tax money for fraud, waste and abuse.
7. I will fully defend the Colorado Open Records Act (CORA) and do everything in my power to protect it, including voting for legislation that increases government transparency, and voting against any attempt to limit Colorado's Sunshine Laws.
8. I will support holding criminals who commit violence and theft accountable, and will also recognize that victimless crimes are not actual crimes.



- 9. In order to support Colorado Agriculture & Ranchers, I will support food freedom, such as local meat processing, raw milk, cottage food producers and repealing restrictions on traditionally laid eggs. 
- 10. I will stand up for parents and families by voting to protect their right to raise their children by their own standards and beliefs. 
- 11. I will vote against any new restrictions on our Right to Keep and Bear Arms and repeal existing restrictions. 
- 12. I will support and defend the right of direct ballot access by citizen initiative. 
- 13. I will support legislation to limit the Emergency Powers of the Governor, and oppose any attempt to abuse those powers. 
- 14. I will defend medical freedom by opposing any mandatory vaccine program or any attempt to create a "vaccine passport" system. 
- 15. I will support ending Civil Asset Forfeiture to ensure that only individuals convicted of a crime should have their property confiscated. 
- 16. I will introduce or support a version of the Defend the Guard Act. _____
- 17. I will vote to ban red light cameras, speed cameras and other unwarranted surveillance devices. 
- 18. I will support the ability of peaceful people to live their lives freely without government interference. 
- 19. I will support and uphold the rights of individuals afforded in the Colorado and US Constitutions.
