## ASRM Altman Self-Rating Mania Scale

## Introduction

The Altman Self-Rating Mania Scale (ASRM) is a diagnostic tool designed to assess the presence and severity of manic symptoms in individuals. In clinical practice, the ASRM serves several functions beyond the initial diagnosis of bipolar disorder. It is often used in the ongoing management enabling healthcare professionals to track the effectiveness of treatment over time and adjust interventions accordingly.
