Purpose:

This resource is designed to build phonemic awareness—the ability to hear, identify, and manipulate individual sounds in spoken words. It helps children practice segmenting and blending sounds to decode familiar words.

How to use:

1. Introduce the Activity

- Say: "I'm thinking of something... and it is a c-a-t."
- Speak slowly and clearly, emphasising each phoneme.

2. Encourage Listening & Blending

- Ask: "Can you guess what word I'm thinking of?"
- Allow time for children to blend the sounds and respond.

3. Reveal the Picture

- Flip the card to show the image.
- Celebrate correct guesses and gently support incorrect ones by repeating the sounds together.
