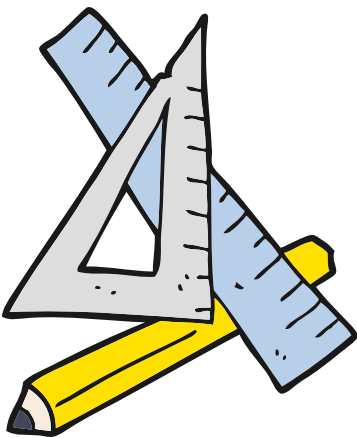
Math Department General Supplies:

It is recommended that Geometry and Algebra 2 students have colored pencils and/or highlighters.

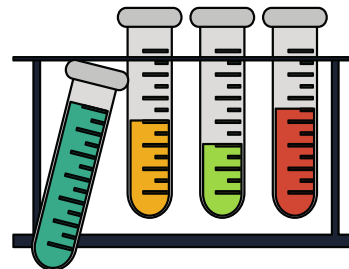
# Science Supply List

Required supplies for all Science classes:

- Scientific or graphing calculator

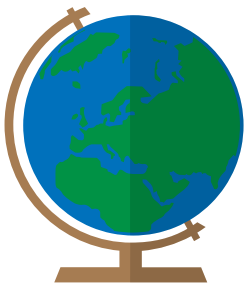
AP Chemistry\*

## General List
