- 1. Health & Safety, Victoria Diaz
  - a. In October, the committee set up a Teal Pumpkin display at the schools to educate children about food allergies and safe items that could be distributed on Halloween
  - b. The committee will continue to promote their Don't Text and Drive and Don't Pass the Flash programs throughout the year
  - c. In January/February, they are looking into the possibility of bringing in a guest speaker to discuss childrens' self-esteem
  - d. In April the committee will be promoting their annual Bike Safety and Safe Driving campaigns
  - e. May will feature the committee's Sun Safety program
- 2. Reflections, Hana Noble
  - a. Hana is co-chairing the Reflections committee with Wa Phung this year
  - b. Submissions for the contest closed on October 31st and 150 submissions were made across all the Garden City Public Schools
  - c. Judges are now reviewing the entries and an award ceremony for the school district winners will take place in March
- 3. Pick a Reading Partner (PARP), Hana Noble
  - a. Hana is co-chairing the PARP committee with Alyssa Vitez this year
  - b. This year's theme is Choose Your Own Adventure
  - c. The committee had a table with books and games at last night's Elementary Math & Literacy Family Night at Stratford
  - d. On Nov. 22nd, a day off of school, the committee will host a movie day at Malverne Movie Theater at 10am that is geared towards Elementary students
  - e. In December, the committee will host their annual virtual reading of The Polar Express
  - f. In January/February, PARP will launch the Garden City Pen Pals program where students can be matched with a pen pal from another GC school
  - g. On Feb. 6th, PARP will host an event with the GC Public Library that will include a Valentine's Day book reading and craft

1. Presentation "Speech/Language Supports" was given by Ms. Ruby Klein, Primary School Speech/Language Pathologist. Ms. Klein explained that once a week she pushes into the Primary School classrooms for 40 minutes, she also provides support to students who require extra help once per week for 30 minutes, and in addition she is part of the evaluation team for CSE/CPSE.
