- LICC is free, anonymous, and confidential 24/7 Hotline (516) 679-1111
- Allows parents to talk about issues facing their children without "stigma."
- "No Health Without Mental Health" need to focus not just on physical health
  - o Diagnosable mental health disorders are on the rise.
- Anxiety is an issue. Schools try to recognize early warning signs and identify children at risk. Long term anxiety can lead to depression, so early intervention is important.
- Empathy v. Sympathy for your children
- "Helicopter Parents" are being replaced by "Snowplow Parents" who clear out obstacles for their children. You can't fix everything, and it takes away problem-solving opportunities. Let your children know you believe in them.
- Encourage connections. Every child should have "one trusted adult."
- Let children know failure is ok. They need to get out of their comfort zones. It is better to start now than later.
- Promote a "Growth Mindset" (failure is an opportunity to grow) vs. a "Fixed Mindset" (failure is the limit of my abilities).
