SIMPLE PREP TIPS

Here are our top wardrobe tips for your upcoming headshot session. Bring a few more options than you think you'll need - we'll help pare them down when you arrive.

Fit

- Slim-fit shirts and jackets always photograph best. Boxy or oversized tops add bulk on camera.

Patterns

- Avoid busy patterns, graphics, or loud prints - they pull attention away from your face.
- Ties are the exception. Print ties are great.

Color

- Pack a mix: one light (white, gray, pastel), one dark (black, navy, charcoal), and one pop of color (something that works with your eyes or brand).

Layers

- A fitted jacket or v-neck sweater adds polish and variety. Layers also help slim the frame on camera.

Casual Options

- Long sleeves are always more polished than short sleeves. Try a knit henley, or roll the sleeves of a button-down for a relaxed look.

Classic Suit

- You can't go wrong with a collared shirt and dark, fitted jacket.
- Without a tie = relaxed, approachable.
- With a tie = more professional and formal.

Accessories

- Glasses (on or off), rings, watches, and cufflinks all work well. Even holding glasses can add personality.

Hands & Grooming

- Hands often show in headshots. Keep nails clean and trimmed.
- Give your watch and rings a quick polish if you're wearing them.

Shoes & Socks

- Bring coordinating shoes and socks to finish the look.
