Actress and filmmaker Giovannie Espiritu was nominated alongside Academy Award Nominees Alfre Woodard and Amy Irving for Best Supporting Actress at MethodFest for the Mynah Films feature film Fiona's Script. Her primetime credits include a recurring role on ER (NBC), Bones (FOX), Gilmore Girls (ABC), and Trauma (NBC). She can currently be seen as the lead in the Amazon series, "Dyke Central," which was featured in After Ellen, BuzzFeed, Bust Magazine and Curve Magazine as a top LGBTQ series to watch.

As a filmmaker, she was featured in Elizabeth Banks' WhoHaHa Media for her parody song, "An Introvert's World," and her storytelling has been featured in Ms. Magazine. A three-time Outfest Fusion Filmmaker, her short film, "Ultra-Feminist," was awarded Honorable Mention. Her film, "Ally3000," just won Best Screenplay at the Culture and Diversity Film Festival (Los Angeles) and the Cyrus International Film Festival (Toronto). It also picked up several awards in the categories of Social Justice / Women Filmmakers / Scriptwriting / Humorist in the IndieFEST Film Awards and International Best Shorts Awards. She is a member of the Alliance of Women Directors and the Producer's Guild of America.

She coaches kids/teens/adults online internationally through HollywoodActorsWorkshop.com and was named as one of the top 40 Audition Coaches in Los Angeles by the Hollywood Winners Circle. Notable student alumni include William Lipton (Daytime Emmy Nominee, Cameron on General Hospital) and the Espina Sisters (Hosts of Dreamworks' "Life Hacks for Kids on the Road").

In her spare time, she rock climbs and advocates for Domestic Violence Awareness/Prevention and LGBTQ equality. She has served on the Board of Directors for C.O.R.A. New voices discovered at our most recent pitch workshop!












Last month, we launched a virtual workshop for inclusive storytellers and heard wonderful stories from new voices including "Chindia" by writer Sikandar Sidhu, a romantic comedy about an Indian man who gives his American dream one last shot by inviting his entire family to a fake wedding in Los Angeles with a Chinese woman. Writer Lowam Eyasu and producing partner Jess Jacklin presented "Frida," a drama about a widowed eighty-year old who retreats from a nursing home to stop the sale of her summer cottage which happens to be the sole memory of her long-lost love with another woman.

During the workshop, the judges and audience members also had the opportunity to vote on their favorites.

Congratulations to Writer, Director and Actress Glovannie Espiritu for being voted by our panel of judges as the winner of the best pitched project. Her film "Dis-Graced" is a religious satire/comedy about a husband who cheats on his devout Christian wife. After the affair, she is shunned by her congregation and undergoes a journey to experience life and love all over again – sprinkled in with some bad behavior with the help of a rebellious rocker.

We would also like to give a shout out to Director and Producer Christopher Oroza-Nostas for being voted as the audience favorite for "Casa Quemada." This drama was inspired by true events and explores the lives of three disparate characters at the epicenter of one of Bolivia's most tragic murders—the lynching of Juana Mayta, a trans woman burned alive by a mob of four hundred in El Alto, Bolivia.





SAN FRANCISCO — Manila-born actor Giovannie "Gio" Espiritu defies the definition of undocumented immigrants according to the current tenant of the White House.


