

## 1--- Naples SAR How To Use Zelle 11/07/25

To set up Zelle, you need a U.S. checking or savings account, a U.S. mobile number or email address, and access to your bank's mobile app or online banking to enroll. First, confirm if your bank offers Zelle, then sign up within your bank's app or website using your phone number or email. You will be prompted to accept terms and may need to verify your identity with a one-time code.

### **Step 1: Check if your bank offers Zelle**

- Log in to your bank's mobile app or online banking.
- Look for a "Pay & Transfer," "Send Money," or a dedicated "Zelle" option.
- If you don't see it, your bank may not offer Zelle, or you may need to check its website to see if it's available.

### **Step 2: Enroll through your bank's platform**

- Select "Send Money with Zelle" or the Zelle setup option within your bank's app.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to enroll. Provide either a U.S. mobile number or an email address to link to your account.
- You may need to enter a one-time code sent to your phone or email to verify your identity.

### **Step 3: Select your receiving account**

- Choose the U.S. checking or savings account you want to use for Zelle transfers.
- 

### **Step 4: Start sending and receiving Zelle**

- Once enrolled, you can start sending and receiving money immediately by selecting a recipient's U.S. mobile number or email address, entering the amount, **adding the REASON (IN THE REVIEW SECTION.)** and confirming the transaction. You may add info in the review section up to 140 spaces. You may be able to avoid mailing anything this way. If there is no **REASON** the payment will be considered a donation.

- It's recommended to double-check the recipient's information before sending, as Zelle transfers are generally irreversible.
