**Contents of application:**

- Sealed, current transcript;
- Letter of recommendation from advisor/relevant instructor;
- Letter from applicant that addresses the following questions:
  - o *What experiences do you have relevant to gardening, farming or your major?*
  - o *What are your career plans, as they relate to gardening, farming or your major?*
  - o *How have your experiences, discussed in the response to first question, shaped the development of your career plans?*

**The selection committee may interview applicants. Interviews will be conducted to clarify basic details: residence, previous educational experience, etc; details about past experiences with gardening, farming, your major; details about future plans, particularly as they related to gardening, farming, your major.**

**All applicants will be notified, in writing, of the selection committee’s decision by August 1st of the application year. A minimum of one \$ 500 scholarship per year is granted. Applicants may apply in multiple years provided all requirements have been met.**
